## NASSCO certification in Pipeline Assessment and Certification Program (PACP), Manhole Assessment and Certification Program (MACP) and Lateral Assessment and Certification Program (LACP). (3 day course)

April 1, 2 & 5—Millbury, MA (see reverse for directions)

PACP is an internationally accepted method for recording pipeline defects and observations in a standardized fashion to improve management of infrastructure deterioration and renewal. Woodard & Curran offers this PACP training in a three (3) day, in-person course where each student can become certified by NASSCO for the internal condition assessment of underground infrastructure. Included in the PACP training is Lateral Assessment and Certification Program (LACP) and the Manhole Assessment and Certification Program (MACP).

### Materials Covered

- Underground infrastructure condition categorization
- Entering basic and detailed information into the PACP/LACP/MACP

- Identifying and coding structural, O&M, construction and miscellaneous pipeline features
- Identifying and coding conditions found in laterals from mainline, manhole, cleanout or other access point
- Inspection of manholes and other access points

# Richard Alden Training Center, Millbury, MA

## DIRECTIONS:

The Richard Alden Training Center is located in Millbury, MA on Route 20 approximately 1/4 mile West from the intersection of Routes 20 and 146. The facility is located on the grounds of the Upper Blackstone Water Pollution Abatement District (UBWPAD).

**From the North:** Access Route 20 from Route 495 South to Route 290 West OR ... Route 190 South to Route 290 West. From Route 290 West take Exit 12 (Bosnian Square, Route 146 South). From the exit ramp, proceed underneath the Route 290 bridge and bear right following the Route 146 signs. Stay on Route 146 South until the Route 20 West Exit. Follow the signs for Route 20 West, at the third light turn right onto Nip Nap Trail.

**From the South:** From 146 North take the Route 20 West Exit. Stay in the right hand lane and at the fourth set of lights turn right onto Nip Nap Trail.

OR

Access Route 20 from Route 395 North. Take the Route 20 East Exit and continue on Route 20 East through 2 sets of lights. As you approach the Auburn/Worcester line, look for a Wendys restaurant on your left and a McDonalds restaurant on your right for landmarks. Proceed straight through the third set of lights located immediately after these restaurants and Nip Nap Trail will be on your left at the fourth set of lights

OR

From 495 North to the MA Pike West Exit 10A (Worcester/Providence). Go through the toll booth and make a left turn at the light following signs to Route 20 West. Continue straight through the second set of lights and stay in the right lane turning right at the third set of lights onto Nip Nap Trail.

**From the East:** From the MA Pike to Exit 10A (Worcester/Providence). Go through the toll booth and make a left turn at the light following signs to Route 20 West. Continue straight through the second set of lights and stay in the right lane turning right at the third set of lights onto Nip Nap Trail.

OR

Access Route 20 from Route 290 West to the Exit 12 (Brosnihian Square, Route 146 South). At the end of the exit ramp, proceed underneath the Route 290 bridge and bear right following the signs for Route 146. Stay on Route 146 South until the Route 20 West Exit. Take this exit, turn right at the fourth set of lights onto Nip Nap Trail.

**From the West:** From the MA Pike to Exit 10A (Worcester/Providence). Go through the toll booth and take a left at the first set of traffic lights. Continue straight through the next set of lights. Go left at the next set of lights onto Route 20 west. Go right lane at the next set of lights onto Nip Nap Trail. Take the first right light off of Nip Nap Trail and follow through the gates.

**After turning into the entrance of the plant from Nip Nap Trail, the Training Center parking lot will be your first left after the security gate. There is a pedestrian walkway out of the parking lot leading to the Training Center.**
